1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 65B.28, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6Subd. 4. **Completion certificate.** ~~Persons~~ A person 55 years old and older may

1.7retake the original course or take the refresher course every three years and receive a

1.8course completion certificate to remain eligible for the premium reduction in subdivision

1.91. A person 58 years old and older who successfully completes a retaking of the original

1.10course or a refresher course more than three years from the date the person last was

1.11eligible for the premium reduction in subdivision 1 is entitled to reinstatement of this

1.12eligibility. The Department of Public Safety shall provide criteria for the issuance of

1.13the course completion certificates.

1.14**EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.** This section is effective the day following

1.15final enactment and applies to a person who successfully completes the retake of the

1.16original course or the four-hour refresher course established pursuant to this section,

1.17on or after that date.
