BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [161.367] CONCRETE DIAMOND GRINDING AND SAW SLURRY.

In any contract that includes concrete diamond grinding or concrete sawing associated with the construction, improvement, or repair of a road, the commissioner of transportation shall include a special provision relating to resulting concrete slurry.

The special provision must include language requiring removal of slurry by vacuuming; allowing deposit of slurry along the in-slope of the roadway for diamond grinding; prohibiting the contractor from allowing slurry to flow across lanes of traffic or into gutters or other closed drainage facilities; and specifying that slurry shall not be placed closer than 100 feet from natural streams and lakes, or three feet from water-filled ditches.
