1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 161.14, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 104. Michael Gau Memorial Bridge. The bridge over marked U.S. Highway

1.9 169 on Hennepin County State-Aid Highway 9, known as Rockford Road, in the city of

1.10 Plymouth, is designated as "Michael Gau Memorial Bridge." Notwithstanding section

1.11 161.139, the commissioner must adopt a suitable design to mark the bridge and erect

1.12 appropriate signs.
