Chapter 409—S. F. No. 733

[Coded as Section 525.092, Subdivision 1]

An act relating to the records in the office of the clerk of probate court and providing for the destruction of certain vouchers; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 117, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1947, Chapter 117, Section 1, is amended to read:

[525.092] Section 1. Subdivision 1. Destruction of vouchers or reports.

The clerk of the probate court is hereby authorized to destroy all vouchers or receipts filed in estates and guardianship proceedings of record in his office after such estates or guardianships have been closed for a period of 20 years, or more, except receipts for any federal or state taxes.
