later extensions or improvements are made but which are not initially assessed therefor, the municipality may also reimburse itself by adding all or any of the portion of the cost so paid to the assessments levied for any of such later extensions or improvements, provided that notice that such additional amount will be assessed is included in the notice of hearing on the making of such extensions or improvements. The additional assessments herein authorized may be made whether or not the properties assessed were included in the area described in the notice of hearing on the making of the original improvement.

## CHAPTER 843—S.F. No. 1103 [Coded in Part]

An act relating to the limitation of actions for damages resulting from the establishment of street or highways grades and changes therein; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 541.07.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 541.07, is amended to read:

- 541.07 Two year limitations. The following actions shall be commenced within two years:
- (1) For libel, slander, assault, battery, false imprisonment, or other tort, resulting in personal injury, and all actions against physicians, surgeons, dentists, hospitals, sanitariums, for mal-practice, error, mistake or failure to cure, whether based on contract or tort; provided a counter-claim may be pleaded as a defense to any action for services brought by a physician, surgeon, dentist, hospital or sanitarium, after the limitations herein described notwithstanding it is barred by the provisions of this chapter, if it was the property of the party pleading it at the time it became barred and was not barred at the time the claim sued on originated, but no judgment thereof except for costs can be rendered in favor of the party so pleading it;
  - (2) Upon a statute for a penalty or forfeiture;
- (3) For damages caused by a dam, other than a dam used for commercial purposes; but as against one holding under the pre-emption or homestead laws, such limitations shall

not begin to run until a patent has been issued for the land so damaged;

- (4) Against a master for breach of an indenture of apprenticeship; the limitation, in such case, to run from the expiration of the term of service;
- (5) For the recovery of wages or overtime or damages, fees or penalties accruing under any federal or state law respecting the payment of wages or overtime or damages, fees or penalties, (the term "wages" as used herein shall mean all remuneration for services or employment, including commissions and bonuses and the cash value of all remuneration in any medium other than cash, where the relationship of master and servant exists and the term "damages", as used herein, shall mean single, double or treble damages, accorded by any statutory cause of action whatsoever and whether or not the relationship of master and servant exists).
- (6) For damages caused by the establishment of a street or highway grade or a change in the originally established grade.
- Sec. 2. [541.071] Special limitation. An action to recover damages heretofore caused by the establishment of a street or highway grade or a change in the originally established grade may be brought within the time prescribed in Section 1 or within six months after the passage of this act, whichever is the longer period.

The management and supervision of the maintenance and care of the abandoned cemeteries, and abandoned or neglected private cemeteries, or the removal of bodies as herein provided shall be delegated by the county board to the county highway department or to some existing cemetery association, veterans organization or Boy
