CHAPTER 1-S. F. No. 11

An act relating to certificates of indebtedness issued by the state and providing for their negotiability.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [335.033] Certificates of indebtedness issued by state, negotiability. Certificates of indebtedness and interest coupons appurtenant thereto, heretofore or hereafter issued by the state of Minnesota in anticipation of the collection of taxes and payable as to principal and interest exclusively from the proceeds of such taxes, shall be negotiable instruments within the meaning and for all purposes of the negotiable instruments law, being Minnesota Statutes 1957, Chapter 335, notwithstanding that they are payable from a particular fund.
