

CHAPTER 578—H. F. No. 381

An act relating to the licensing and registering of veterinarians and for the revocation of licenses; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 156.07.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 156.07 is amended to read:

156.07. Veterinarians; annual registration. Each person now qualified to practice veterinary medicine in this state, or who shall hereafter be licensed by the veterinary examining board to engage in such practice, shall register with the board before the first day of May each year and thereupon the license of such veterinarian shall be renewed for such calendar year.

The fee for such registration shall be \$2 and shall be paid by each licensed veterinarian in this state to the secretary of the board before the first day of May each year.

Any such veterinarian failing so to register and pay this registration fee before May first each year shall pay to the secretary-treasurer of the board the sum of \$5 before his license shall be renewed; provided, that in the event any such licensed veterinarian fails to register and to pay the registration fee provided herein within 60 days after May first in any year, then and in that event the board shall revoke his license to practice veterinary medicine in this state.

Any person who, on March 31, 1937, shall be legally licensed to practice veterinary medicine in this state shall be entitled to receive a license to continue such practice upon making application to the board and complying with the terms of this section for annual registration.

Any person who was qualified to practice veterinary medicine or or before March 31, 1937, and who has remained active in the field of veterinary medicine for a period of 35 years but who has failed to register with the state veterinary examining board may receive a license to practice veterinary medicine upon making application to the board and complying with the terms of this section for annual registration.
