CHAPTER 423—H. F. No. 1616

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 169.20, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 169.20, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Highway traffic; intersections; right of way.** The driver of a vehicle *intending to turn to the left* within an intersection *or into an alley, private road, or driveway intending to turn to the left* shall yield the right of way to any vehicle approaching from the opposite direction which is within the intersection or so close thereto as to constitute an immediate hazard; ~~but the driver, having so yielded and having given a signal when and as required by this chapter, may make such left turn, and the drivers of all other vehicles approaching the intersection from the opposite direction shall yield the right of way to the vehicle making the left turn.~~
