

CHAPTER 282—S. F. No. 1295

An act relating to village and town assessors; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 273.05, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Sec. 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 273.05, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

273.05 Local assessors; appointments, term, bond and oath.
Subdivision 1. Appointment of town, village and city assessors. Notwithstanding any other provision of law all town assessors shall be appointed by the town board, all village assessors shall be appointed by the village council or other appointing authority as provided by law, and notwithstanding any charter provisions to the contrary, all city assessors shall be appointed by the city council or other appointing authority as provided by law or charter. Such assessors shall be residents of the state but need not be a resident of the town, village, or city for which they are appointed. They shall be selected and appointed because of their knowledge and training in the field of property taxation. The term of all town and village assessors shall expire on December 31, 1968. Thereafter all ~~succeeding terms shall be for a period of two years; town and village assessors shall be appointed for indefinite terms.~~ *Vacancies in the office of village assessors shall be filled by appointment of the village council. When a vacancy in the office of village assessor is not filled by appointment as provided in this section before the first day of January following its occurrence, the county auditor shall appoint some resident of the county as assessor for such village.*
