Sec. 2. Such lease shall be conditioned upon the continued use of said premises as a center for the counseling and treatment of alcoholics and their families, and upon discontinuance for such use such lease shall become null and void and the boards of county commissioners of Polk and Norman counties shall also have the right of reentry thereon.

Sec. 3. This act shall be effective upon its approval by the governing bodies of the counties of Polk and Norman, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 368—H. F. No. 1940

[Coded]

An act relating to insurance; notification to policyholders of insolvent company.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **[60A.25] Insurance; insolvent companies, notification of policyholders.** Whenever any foreign or domestic insurance company is adjudicated insolvent, or whenever its policies are declared null and void by court order, the commissioner of insurance shall ascertain the names and last known addresses of all Minnesota policyholders of said company, and shall notify all Minnesota policyholders within 30 days of such adjudication or court order.
