

(b) The court has jurisdiction to conduct preliminary hearings and to exercise all judicial powers incident to preliminary hearing proceedings, on any charge of violation of any criminal law of this state committed within Ramsey county.

(c) ~~Jurisdiction under sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) of paragraph (a) and under paragraph (b) of this subdivision is exclusive for any violation committed within the city of Saint Paul; jurisdiction under paragraph (b) of this subdivision is exclusive for any violation committed inside the city of Saint Paul or inside that part of the village of St. Anthony lying inside Ramsey county.~~

CHAPTER 361—S.F.No.1731

An act relating to courts; establishing salary for court reporters in fourth judicial district; amending Laws 1969, Chapter 568, Section 1, Subdivision 1, as amended; and Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 486.06, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1969, Chapter 568, Section 1, Subdivision 1, as amended by Laws 1971, Chapter 608, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **DISTRICT COURTS; REPORTERS; COMPENSATION; FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.** Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, Section 486.05, or any other law to the contrary, the salary of district court reporters in the fourth judicial district is established at ~~\$14,500~~ \$16,500 per year, as of the ~~effective date of this act~~ January 1, 1973, exclusive of insurance benefits. The salary shall be paid in biweekly installments in the same manner as Hennepin county employees are paid. Such reporters shall not be under the jurisdiction of the Hennepin county personnel board.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 486.06, as amended by Laws 1973, Chapter 111, Section 2, is amended to read:

486.06 CHARGE FOR TRANSCRIPT. In addition to such salary, the reporter may charge for a transcript of his record ordered by any person other than the judge 35 cents per folio thereof and seven and one-half cents per folio for each manifold or

other copy thereof when so ordered that it can be made with such transcript. This section shall not apply to any county containing a city of the first class which city has more than 150,000 residents.

CHAPTER 362—S.F.No.1782

An act relating to the county of McLeod; tax levy for road and bridge purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **MCLEOD COUNTY; ROAD AND BRIDGE TAX LEVY.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 163.05, the county of McLeod may levy a tax of not to exceed 30 mills on the dollar of the taxable valuation of the county for county road and bridge purposes.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by the board of county commissioners of McLeod county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
