CHAPTER 102—S.F.No.2537

An act relating to highways; adding an additional highway route to the highway routes designated as the Blue Star memorial highway; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 161.14, Subdivision 13.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 161.14, Subdivision 13, is amended to read:

Subd. 13. **HIGHWAYS; BLUE STAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.** Trunk Highway Routes Numbered 390, 392, 394, and 395, as described in Minnesota Statutes, Section 161.12, are hereby named and designated as the Blue Star Memorial Highway.

Subject to the approval of the commissioner of highways, the Blue Star Memorial marker may be placed in roadside rest areas, waysides, or parking areas within the right-of-way of the routes described in the first paragraph of this subdivision.

CHAPTER 103—S.F.No.2952 [Not Coded]

An act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing passenger automobiles furnished by a dealer or manufacturer without charge to delegates and guests of the 1974 Midwest Governors' Conference to operate such passenger automobile on the streets and highways between certain dates without payment of the motor vehicle registration tax.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **MIDWEST GOVERNORS' CONFERENCE; VEHICLE TAX EXEMPTIONS.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 168, or any other law, a manufacturer or dealer, furnishing without charge any passenger automobile for the delegates and
