CHAPTER 65-H.F.No.923

An act relating to energy; postponing the deadline for promulgation of energy conserving building design and construction standards by the commissioner of administration; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 116H.12, Subdivision 4.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 116H.12, Subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. ENERGY; BUILDING STANDARDS; PROMULGATION DATE. In recognition of the compelling need for energy conservation in order to safeguard the public health, safety and welfare, it is necessary to provide building design and construction standards consistent with the most efficient use of energy. Therefore, the commissioner of administration, in consultation with the director, shall, no later than April-August 1, 1975, and pursuant to chapter 15, promulgate building design and construction standards regarding heat loss control, illumination and climate control. Such standards shall apply to all new buildings and remodeling affecting heat loss control, illumination and climate control. Such standards shall be economically feasible in that the resultant savings in energy procurement shall exceed the cost of the energy conserving requirements amortized over the life of the building. The standards shall become part of the state building code and be effective six months after promulgation.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following its final enactment.
