## SPECIAL LAWS ENACTED IN THE 1998 REGULAR SESSION AND THE 1998 FIRST SPECIAL SESSION RELATING TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS

This table lists special laws enacted in 1998 relating to local government units if there is an express statement in the special law that local approval is required or not required or if for any reason the local government unit has filed a certificate of local approval with the Secretary of State.

If the special law expressly states that local approval is not required, the term "Not required" appears to the right of the chapter citation. All other laws listed in the table contain express requirements of local approval or are laws for which local approval certificates were filed regardless of whether the filing was required.

If a local approval certificate has been filed with the Secretary of State in compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, before June 1, 1998, the approval and filing dates are indicated. A blank space after a chapter citation indicates that a local approval certificate had not been filed by June 1, 1998.
