

CHAPTER 52—S. F. No. 639

An act relating to legal holidays; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 334.08 and Section 645.44, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 334.08, is amended to read :

334.08 Date due or performable; Sundays and legal holidays. Any contract, promissory note, draft, check, acceptance, bill of exchange, or instrument becoming due or performable on Sunday or a legal holiday becomes due or performable on the next succeeding business day. When Sunday and a legal holiday fall on the same day the following day is a legal holiday. When Sunday and a legal holiday or when legal holidays fall on successive days any contract, promissory note, draft, check, acceptance, bill of exchange, or instrument becoming due on any of those days becomes due or performable on the business day next succeeding the last day thereof. *The Monday following a legal holiday shall not be deemed a legal holiday for the transaction of public business by the legislature.*

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 645.44, Subdivision 5, is amended to read :

Subd. 5. **Holidays.** "Holiday" includes New Year's Day, January 1; Lincoln's Birthday, February 12; Washington's Birthday, February 22; Memorial Day, May 30; Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, the first Monday in September; Christopher Columbus Day, October 12; Christmas Day, December 25; the Friday next preceding Easter Sunday, commonly known as Good Friday; Thanksgiving Day; and Veterans Day, November 11; provided, when New Year's Day, January 1; or Memorial Day, May 30; or Independence Day, July 4; or Christmas Day, December 25; falls on Sunday, the following day shall be a holiday. No public business shall be transacted on any holiday, except in cases of necessity *and except in cases of public business transacted by the legislature,* nor shall any civil process be served thereon.
