

“Motorized bicycle” means a motor powered vehicle consisting of an arrangement or combination of two wheels, one following the other, supported by a frame designed to be propelled by the feet acting upon pedals.

“Utility trailer” means a motorless vehicle equipped with one or two wheels and having a carrying capacity of 2000 pounds or less and used for carrying property on its own structure while being drawn by a motor vehicle.

CHAPTER 53—S. F. No. 553

An act relating to motor vehicles and mobile homes owned by a nonresident; providing for one-way trip permits under certain conditions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [168.82] **One-way trip permits.** [Subdivision 1.] Whenever a person seeks to operate a motor vehicle or tow a mobile home owned by a nonresident upon the highways of this state solely for the purpose of transporting it from a point outside the state to another point outside the state, and such vehicle is not otherwise exempt from registration and taxation as provided by law, such owner shall not be required to register the vehicle and pay the tax but in lieu thereof shall apply in writing to the registrar for a one-way trip permit and pay a fee of \$10. Unless such act of transportation also requires approval by the commissioner of highways as provided in section 169.86, such person may be permitted to proceed with such vehicle into the state, not to exceed 35 miles, to the nearest city or village wherein a deputy registrar is located before securing such permit. The application for permit shall be in such form and contain such information as the registrar may determine. Any motor vehicle operated under such permit shall carry no load. As used in this act, “person” includes a natural person, firm, copartnership, association, or corporation.

Sec. 2. [Subd. 2.] Fees collected pursuant to section 1 of this act shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the highway user tax distribution fund.
