- Sec. 4. St. Louis county; work relief program. The county may contract with the federal government, or with any department, agency, subdivision, or instrumentality of the state, or with any political subdivision within the county, for the services of such work relief recipients on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon, with or without consideration paid to the county.
- Sec. 2. This act shall not become effective until after its approval by a majority vote of the county welfare board and a majority vote of the St. Louis county board, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 627-H. F. No. 671

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 169.18, Subdivision 9.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 169.18, Subdivision 9, is amended to read:
- Subd. 9. Traffic regulations; divided highways; crossovers. Whenever any highway has been divided into two or more roadways by leaving an intervening space or by a physical barrier or clearly indicated dividing section so constructed as to impede vehicular traffic, or by a double center line; every vehicle shall be driven only

upon the right-hand roadway and unless directed or permitted to use another roadway by official traffic-control devices or police officers. no No vehicle shall be driven over, across, or within any such dividing space, barrier section, or double center line, except through an opening in such physical barrier, or dividing section or space or at a crossover or intersection established by public authority.

An act relating to instruction in social training.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. [324.01] Limitations on certain contracts for instruction or use of certain social training facilities. Subdivision 1. Contract for life invalid. Any contract for instruction in social skills, or for the use by a patron of a dance hall, studio, ballroom, or other social training facility, which is measured by the life of the person receiving such instruction, or the use of such social training facility as a patron shall be deemed void and unenforceable as contrary to public policy.
- Subd. 2. Contracts for consideration greater than \$500 invalid. Any contract or contracts for instruction in social skills, or for the use by a patron of a dance hall, studio, ballroom, or other social training facility which requires payment by the person receiving such instruction, or the use of such social training facility, of a total amount in excess of \$500, or granting to the person furnishing such instruction or providing the use of such facilities, an automatic renewal option where the payments to be made during the original contract period and the option period combined are in excess of \$500, shall be void in their inception and unenforceable.
- Sec. 2. [324.02] Instruments not to be transferred without consent of maker. No contract for instruction in social skills or for the use by a patron of a dance hall, studio, ballroom, or other social training facility or instrument received in payment thereof, shall be negotiated or assigned without the separate written consent of the person receiving such instruction or the use of such social training facility.
 - Sec. 3. [324.03] Application. Nothing herein shall be

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
