

CHAPTER 307—H.F.No.794

An act relating to corrections; regulating the compensation paid to inmates of state correctional institutions; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 243.23.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 243.23, is amended to read:

243.23 CORRECTIONS; COMPENSATION PAID TO INMATES. ~~Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the commissioner of corrections is authorized and empowered to provide for the payment to prisoners confined in the state prison or in the state reformatory for men, and the Minnesota correctional institution for women inmates of correctional institutions under his management and control of such pecuniary compensation as he may deem proper, such payment to be not less than 20 cents nor more than one dollar per day for each day worked, the amount of compensation to depend upon the quality and character of the work performed as determined by the commissioner of corrections and the warden or superintendent, provided that such prisoners inmates who because of illness or physical disability cannot work may be paid not to exceed 20 cents a minimal amount per day as determined by the commissioner.~~ Such earnings shall be paid out of the fund provided for the carrying on of the work in which the prisoner inmate is engaged when employed on state account, or from the current expense fund of the institution as the commissioner of corrections shall determine.
