Frequently asked questions regarding the Drafting System Replacement

Question:

Section 2.2 notes that the Office of the Revisor of Statutes worked with a business process analyst in 2018 to model the process flows of the office. May we see the output deliverables from that effort?

Answer:

A set of deliverables from the effort will be provided to the selected vendor. Attached is a context diagram that gives an overview of the business processes that were modeled. The modeling effort did not cover all usage of our current system and was limited to the workflows of the revisors office. The current documentation does not include drafting or workflows for other offices that use our current system, or process changes implemented as a result of transitioning to a hybrid work environment during the pandemic.

Question:

Would you provide us representative samples of the documents that ORS produces? The RFP mentions: "bills, resolutions, amendments, engrossments, committee reports, comparison reports, side-by-side comparisons, rules of procedure, messages between legislative bodies, legislative agendas, session journals, memos and letters, bill jackets and covers, and administrative rule drafts." However, if there are other documents generated by the Office of the Revisor of Statutes, samples of those would be great to have as well.

Answer:

Nearly every document that the office produces is available on the legislature's website. For example:

Question:

Section 4.3 talks about "Options for preserving page and line numbers..." Is this referring to the amendment language generation process or something else?

Answer:

The option to preserve page and line numbers is used as a means of more easily ensuring that each piece of amended language is included in an engrossed document. When users proofread an engrossment that results from page and line amendments, it is easier to find the location where an amendment is supposed to go if the user can refer to the old page and line numbers from the previous version of the bill on the new engrossment.

Question:

This section seems to indicate that the new drafting system will need to generate amendments for side-by-side comparisons. Would you provide an example of what this looks like?

Answer:

Question:

Section 4.6 indicates that the templating solution must support configurable autonumbering schemes. Would you explain in more detail what this functionality is and provide an example?

Answer:

A bill section template that includes a placeholder for the bill section number that can then be auto applied based on a numbering scheme.

Question:

Section 4.7 references "searches scanning for errors" being linkable to a report. Would you explain what these searches are and provide a list that need to be included in the new drafting system? Could you also provide some examples?

Answer:

The current system searches documents for errors and links to a Validation Report, an example of which is attached. The search scans for, among other things, bill sections out of statutory order, duplicate action, incorrect bill section header language, invisible symbols copied from Word documents, proposed coding that has already been used, incorrect tagging, repealed cite references, chapter notes for bill sections, and amended statutory content. An example of a Validation Report is attached.

Question:

Section 4.10 talks about delivering formatted and raw document versions. What are you envisioning a "raw document version" to look like and what file format would it be?

Answer:

We currently send HTML, PDF and raw XML to various external offices that have systems that process our documents based on the schema we provide them with for the XML structure. Use of any new formats will have to be coordinated with those offices to ensure effective integration with legacy systems that will continue to be used.

Question:

Section 4.11 talks about "logical grouping of content for user groups." What does "logical grouping" refer to here?

Answer:

The current system groups documents by biennium, document type, office, legislative session, etc. A new system will need to allow for grouping documents in ways that allow users to easily find and access files that they have permissions to access.

Question:

The RFP states the requirement to manage requests from 'legislators, agencies, and other entities' - can you provide us with a list of these agencies and other entities? Please also define the groups and the size of each of the groups that will receive training.

Answer:

The other entities that the system will need to manage request from primarily include constitutional officers (the Governor's Office, Secretary of State, Attorney General, and State Auditor), as well as the executive branch departments and agencies that request Revisor's Office services. A list of the active requesters in the current system is attached; the list is non-

exhaustive, however, as other state entities are often added or removed over. It is also possible that other non-state users be added in the future, should needs evolve.

The current system has approximately 100 nonpartisan users. The future system will further accommodate 200 legislators who will utilize the workflow dashboard and additional partisan staff who will utilize committee workflow.

Ouestion:

Please outline the Revisor Office's evaluation criteria and scoring methodology for responses received.

Answer:

Submissions will be evaluated on the basis of overall responsiveness to the RFP, including the degree to which the proposal meets the general system requirements; ability of proposed data structure to support current system functionality while providing ability to add features/enhancements in the future; integration of the drafting editor with legislative drafter, editorial/codification, and other legislative process workflows; ability of the system to adapt to changing legislative environment, including by modifying or adding features and functions; and overall project cost/timeline.

Question:

Please describe any urgency to retire any specific applications that are now a part of XTEND. Is there one (or two or more) that you believe needs to be phased out first?

Answer:

No, we are committed to keeping the existing drafting system usable and maintained until the new system replaces it.

Question:

Please confirm that all drafting is performed by users on XTEND's Arbortext application. Does this include all legislative documents (including, for example, committee reports)? Is there currently any use of word processing software in the drafting process by the Office of the Revisor or other offices? If so, please describe.

Answer:

Yes, every document listed in the RFP is drafted in Xtend, save for certain communications, memorandums, or other non-legislative documents that are drafted in Word.

Question:

Please describe the role(s) Revisor's Office anticipates or prefers the current IT staff would play in implementing and maintaining a new system.

Answer:

As the long-term caretakers of the new system, our IT staff will be heavily involved in the development process. Our own staff need to be well acquainted with modifying and supporting the newly developed system.

Question:

Regarding the Search requirement (4.7), is this internal search for drafting purposes and/or external facing? Does the Office have a specific vision of what users should be able to do with search results?

Answer:

The current system supports both internal and public searching of our documents. Internal searching is often included in reports, which can be printed. Future systems should continue to support the current searching features. Integration with searching/reporting and a user dashboard with links to reports or notifications would be useful.


